# **Dominic Guerrera**<sup>1</sup>

24 hour news cycle

CCTV footage

'of Aboriginal appearance'

most wanted handcuffed dragged in front of cameras

nightly news first story from the top

the blak criminal is alive and well

don't switch the channel

this is not to be missed

as the revolution will not be televised

but the genocide will

Solution: incarcerate to obliterate

nothing unusual

nothing weird

funny how the footage of blak deaths in custody

always seems to disappear

they are just white men doing their job

in a system design to kill native mob

### LIKE I SAID

they are just white men doing their job

they are not monsters

they are just humans capable of doing monstrous things

we are forced to spend days

in hospitals

in funeral homes

in detention

in prisons

in cop cars

in all your institutions

in our homes - electronically chained to a system we did not volunteer too

yield to

nor did we consent to

lies are not fiction

they are real and continue to hide the real criminals

cops and social workers

chasing hunting

salivating another Blak-child pursuit

catch them

hold them

claiming 'drug addict mother and no father to be found'

child of the state - in the name of the crown

from clown courts

to white foster support

the prey is finally caught

devoured into the system

blak kids taken at rates higher than stolen gen

but tell us how you are 'Sorry' again

while this shit keeps repeating on spin

marketable culture

soft-pink dot paintings printed on

mugs

notebooks

cushions

curtains

homewares

dresses for inner city white women to wear as they cycle to the election booth to vote for the greens

progress?

we've progressed to capitalism

our culture being re-purposed

to make whites feel comfortable

made in china, sold in k-mart

from slave labour to being followed around in the store

just to remind you that you ain't the type of native they wanna adore

they select the ones that want to recognise

placing them in non-threatening poses and clothes

giving non-threatening opinions

placid natives tamed, beautified, stripped of strength

ready to assimilate

watch these whites take the bait

page after page, exotic native-ware

like savage to citizen to constitutional recognition

our Aboriginality is being turned into the pages of the colony

they refuse to recognise our strength

our survival

our resistance

our sovereignty

here's my statement from the heart:

get the fuck off my country

a campaign of master deceptors

assimilation obsession

fraudulent statement

begging, requesting

for the slave driver's favour

liberation will never be found in the house or laws of the oppressor

i won't lean in

i refuse to be institutionalised

there's a reason my nanna escaped the orphanages

you've heard our voices

in the deaths in custody paper

in the bringing them home report

closing the gap review

uncle Mabo in the high court

we speak until our voices are hoarse

cause you can't hear a voice
when your knee is still on my throat

cause of our death: hope, faith and symbolism murdered by: an ignorant genocidal system

it's a bait and switch that's why there's so many holes in the pitch

kids in cadell detention centre

NT intervention

up held by 7 consecutive PMs
social work observing while mothers in labour
payment cards on the west coast
government smoke, governmental choke
and this is the system that's gonna heal this shit?

false prophets, false hope
our sovereignty never ceded
but neither has your white supremacy

there is no spiritual in the political no cultural in the provincial there is no lore in the opinion

yes there are blak people who are culturally bankrupt

bougie blaks

chasing australian order

adjacent to the enemy

causing identity disorder

warrior imitator

vanilla innovator

singing colonisers songs

in language

now how the fuck can you decolonise that

'i still call australia home'...?

we never called home 'australia' to begin with

neo-liberal Aboriginals

cosplaying culture

like a white person at WOMAD

time for you to repent

time for you to relent
time to sit back on country
not in the lap of meritocracy
you went from songlines to sellout-legacy
and you're meant to be emblematic of our community?

Whites always getting off so easily
your only task is to rock up on voting day
then you can return to your houses on stolen land
to rest easy, knowing the whites are still in command
mission managers
a paternalistic grip

fuelled by your white-guilt trip

"we just wanna help break the Indigenous glass ceiling"
how about, just pay the rent and fuck off with your feelings
you try to infiltrate

chasing Blak dick

for a Blak kid

still don't make you Blak, sis

chasing Blak jobs

for Blak money

still don't make you Blak, buddy our community, not yours we are not yours

your country is racist
your government is racist
your departments are racist
your no vote, your yes vote is racist
the whole campaign is racist
this has caused more pain than it can solve

when you put Aboriginal issues into the binary of white politics

it's Aboriginal people who are always going to lose

always going to be bruised

offering colonial crumbs
maybe a seat, a meal at their table
while side tracking, land snatching
kid stealing if they are able

time to revolt

time for revolution

take back the farms and productions lines

liberate land, liberate the minds

liberate sacred sites from destroying mines
break the unions/ labor party bind
we can't wait
nothing will be addressed from them
because government has excused for everything

australia is an illegitimate country
upheld by an unconstitutional constitution
the document, resting in the house of lords
where they plotted and schemed
then reported back their evil deeds
interbreed whited aristocrats
sent in their convicts like feral cats
a royal claim royal reign
more like british shit stain

their legacy is trauma demonic empire order and I hope that queen is enjoying her time in hell

don't parody the colony - solutions are abound tangible outcomes, expand blak ontology

community control over health, legal aid, education, arts, environment and every occupation missions thriving - community is medicinal time for native values native beliefs

native principles
always was, always will be treaty first
land back, liberation
fuelled by native epistemology
fuelled by native ingenuity
fuelled by native rage
